

Do I need to complete all of the activities?

Parents can choose the activities they think will work best for their child or children, or they can allow pupils to choose which activities they complete and when.

Should I mark my child's work?

You don't need to give formal marking, but it is always helpful to chat and give feedback! You could ask them:

"What went well?"

"How could you make it even better?"

"What would you do differently next time?"

What if my child has already done this Espresso activity?

Some children may have logged in to try different activities already! If this happens, they can browse Espresso and find a different activity to try instead.

What if I don't have a laptop or device available for my child?

RE: If children cannot access the video, you could have a family discussion about faith and celebration! Ask if your child can identify places of worship or special books for different religions.

Music: if you are not able to access the clips using this link, try listening to CDs if you have them at home, or Classic FM radio if possible! If classical music is not possible, you can listen to any music you have at home, or sing and draw together.

Science: Think about different materials that do and do not conduct electricity. What materials are used around the home to allow electricity to pass and what materials do not allow electricity to pass. Look in information books (if you have any).

The optional extra work for science does not need the use of a laptop or device.
