Extension:

Remember, when we add **s** to most words ending in **y** we change the **y** to **i** and add **es**, like this:

one lolly → three loll**ies**

But if the word ends in a single **vowel (a e i o u) + y**, we simply add **s**, like this:

one monkey → three monkey**s**
