Could this be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - driven by love? - family expectations? - this is how males / females behave? - consequences of previous actions <p><i>This is the same as yesterday, but today you will compare your two different characters.</i></p>	<p>LO: To write a letter in character from Romeo and Juliet</p> <p>Near the end of the story of Romeo and Juliet a message/ letter was written for Romeo explaining the plan for faking Juliet's death. However, Romeo did not receive this letter. Think about what information would be in the letter – this could be written either from Juliet herself or the friar. The letter needs to include the content seen above.</p> <p><i>Extension:</i> <i>How do you think Romeo will respond?</i></p>
