Great Staughton and Kimbolton Primary Academy Year 6 Home Learning Frequently Asked Questions

Does my child need to complete all of the activities?

It is anticipated that most children will complete most of the activities during the two week period. As a parent, you may wish to select the activities that would work best for your child(ren). Or you may allow your child(ren) to decide what to choose and when to complete them.

What should I do when work has been completed?

We do not expect work to be formally marked. However, acknowledgement of work is always appreciated. You may wish to provide some feedback or just have a helpful chat about work that has been completed.

As a parent, I do not understand the task. How can I help my child(ren)?

If this occurs, see if your child(ren) understands the task before doing anything else. You may wish to look online to see if there are any tips that could be used. You could also contact your child's teacher (via Facebook or email the school).

What do I do if the link provided on the learning grid does not work?

All links have been checked before grids have been uploaded. Any additional materials should be accessible on the school website under the class name and home learning link. If the internet is down, use of books could provide suitable information or a chat as a family might help combine knowledge.

What happens when more than one person needs to use the computer/iPad?

As often as possible, YouTube links have been used. YouTube is accessible on most Smart TVs. If you need to use a computer/iPad, then select a different activity to complete until the machine is available.

Does my child need to complete the optional extra work (alternate weeks)?

Work on the optional extra grid is follow up work. This work has been designed to get your child(ren) to delve a little deeper into what has been set before. For some subjects the optional extra work is the same - as this work might take longer than you first think. This work is optional and will not prevent your child(ren) to understand the next set of work.

Does the bonus activity need to be completed?

This work alternates between an English or a maths focus. Ideally this activity will be completed, however we know that this may not always be possible. Decide if this activity will benefit your child(ren).

Is there any other work that should be completed?

Children should be reading regularly and completing an AR quiz (whenever possible). 60 minutes of Maths Whizz and completing activities on TTRockstars is also a weekly requirement. Online maths work (Maths Whizz and TTRockstars) is monitored weekly by Mr Nelson.
