Topic, Science and Music: I need more information that what is provided from the links. What do I do?

Topic and Science: Additional websites can be used to gain more information. A simple Google search should be sufficient. Make sure in the search engine you add the words 'for kids', 'for children' or 'KS2' - this will refine the search to child appropriate material.

Music: If BBC Bitesize doesn't work, then read the information on the grid to get a brief summary of what the content would have been online.

PE: What can I do if I can't access YouTube? My child doesn't get motivated with the link provided for PE?

The most important thing is that your child is physically active for part of the day. When at school, we access PE for 2hrs a week, plus the physical excursion of playtime and lunchtime. Get your child active by completing a few cardio activities before stretching or playing any physical game. Ensure you complete a cool down after physical activities.

Art: What can I do if I have no flowers in the garden?

Get your child to look in some magazines, books or online to find some suitable flowers for the task.

Why is the computing task the same as the previous week?

There is plenty of content in the stated block of work to last for two weeks. If you wish to progress that is fine. If knowledge isn't secure, take a look at previous years based activities. Work at a pace and level that is suitable for your child.

Where can I find different versions of the Easter story?
