### <u>Topic:</u> What is a fact file? Does the work need to be completed on a <u>computer?</u>

A fact file is a collection of information about a particular subject. There is no specific length for a fact file, but different areas of the one subject need to be covered. This work can be completed on paper or a computer. The important part of the task is the content, not the medium used to present work.

### RE: What religions should be selected to complete this activity?

You can decide or your child can decide which religions to compare. Select ones that you know some information about, so you have a starting point.

### Science: I can't access Espresso link. What can I do?

Children have the username and password to access Espresso. If this has been misplaced, ask a friend. The username and password is the same for all children in GS and the same for all children in KPA.

## <u>Music</u>: Beethoven's 5<sup>th</sup> Symphony is quite long. Do we need to listen to all of it?

Listen to as much of the symphony that is needed to complete the activity.

### DT: How does preparing a meal count as DT?

Part of DT involves food and cooking. It is important that children can identify different methods to prepare food and what techniques are used to heat or cool ingredients.
