Topic: I can't access Espresso link. What can I do?

Children have the username and password to access Espresso. If this has been misplaced, ask a friend. The username and password is the same for all children in GS and the same for all children in KPA.

Music: What can I do if I am unable to download an app for this task?

This can be completed without the use of an app. If you have any musical instrument at home, that can be used instead. If you do not have any instruments, gather a few items from around the house that can make a noise.

Bonus activity: How do I measure the volume of a cuboid?

Volume is calculated by length x width x depth/height. Three numbers are multiplied together. You have the answer, so what would the question be? $2 \times 2 \times 2 = volume$

Why is the computing task the same as the previous week?
