DT: We already have a bug hotel in our garden. Do we have to design another one?

The designing stage in DT is very important. If you already have one, use this as a started point and your child(ren) can still design a hotel. If you wish to produce a bug hotel or small creature habitat for a different part of the garden, or even place in a local green area, that would be great.

Bonus activity: Does the poem have to rhyme?

When we think of poetry we can tend to assume lines need to rhyme. This is not always the case. We have rhyming and non-rhyming poems. The most important part of a poem is word choices. Writing a rhyming poem can sometimes constrict vocabulary and children can tend to platy safe with word choices.

Year 6 Home Learning for Optional Extra Work 22nd June 2020 <u>Frequently Asked Questions</u>

Why is the computing task the same as the previous week?

There is plenty of content in the stated block of work to last for two weeks. If you wish to progress that is fine. If knowledge isn't secure, take a look at previous years based activities. Work at a pace and level that is suitable for your child.

Why do the optional extra PE tasks vary from one week to the next?

In the optional week, children are guided to access different types of exercise or dance. You may wish to use Joe Wicks activities every week instead. As previously mentioned, being physical every day is important.

Bonus activity: My child doesn't wish to be recorded, what can I do instead?

Not everyone likes to be recorded. If your child(ren) prefers to just perform to immediate family members - enjoy the exclusive performance in the privacy of your own home.
