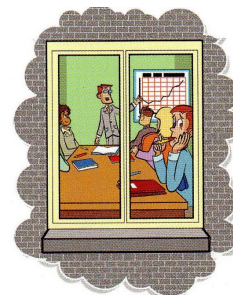

Extension:

It can sometimes help to spell words that have unstressed vowels correctly if we think of the syllables.

Remember:

- every syllable needs a vowel sound
- when two consonants separate two vowel sounds, the first syllable usually ends after the first consonant
hospital = hos/pi/tal
This reminds us not to spell the word *hospitl*.
