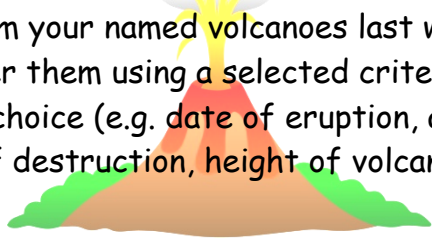
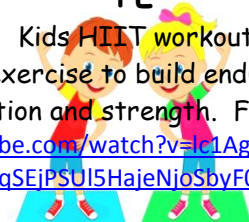


GS Year 6 Optional Extra Work: Week Commencing 27th April 2020
