Dear Parents/Carers,

Young Voices Choir Trip to the O2 on Thursday 22nd January 2026

Young Voices is fast approaching, and we are all getting extremely excited and the children are working hard at learning their songs.

Children will come to school as normal (in full school uniform) on Thursday 22nd January. If your child ordered a Young Voices t-shirt, these will be given out to your child on the day. If your child hasn't ordered a Young Voices t-shirt, they will need to bring a plain white t-shirt please. A clean white P.E. t-shirt will be fine.

Staff and children will be transported to the O2 by coaches and will be departing at approximately 9.00am from Great Staughton Primary Academy, **so please ensure your child arrives at school promptly**. Once at the O2 the children will spend the day rehearsing with all the other schools and will then perform in the evening. The concert is due to finish at 9.15pm, so coaches are scheduled to depart the O2 at 9.30pm and return at approximately 11.30pm. If there are drastic changes to these timings, we will update you via Facebook. If you are not part of our Facebook group, please speak to the office to sign up or to make alternative arrangements.

Please ensure that an emergency contact number, that will be available all day and all evening is provided on the slip below as this number will be used in the event of an emergency. Please also confirm on the slip, the name of the adult who will be collecting your child. **Just a reminder that parents who have bought tickets to watch the performance will need to make their own way to and from the arena.** It will not be possible to collect your child directly from the O2 Arena.

Children will need to bring a warm coat, lots of water (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles) and **TWO** good sized packed lunches as it is a very long day (one for lunch and one for dinner). These must be carried in one backpack type bag which can be easily carried and stored under a seat. Children **must not** bring mobile phones, cameras, money or other valuables, however disposable cameras are allowed. School staff will take photographs that they will put on Facebook and will be in touch with school by phone.

Any medication that we hold for your child in school, will automatically be taken with us. However, if your child requires any medication during the visit, such as travel sickness pills, please contact the school office to complete consent forms. We are unable to administer medication without permission in writing.

Due to the late time of our return, children attending the concert are not required to be in school until 10.00am on the Friday, but if they want to come in at normal time, then that is fine.

If your child requires a school packed lunch (sandwich, fruit, crisps and a biscuit) we will need to know this in advance so please pre-book your child's school meal via the office. However, please remember that they will need another one for the evening.
