### School clubs – Summer Term.

Our lunch time and after school clubs will commence the week beginning 20<sup>th</sup> April 2026. The clubs will run up to and including week commencing 6<sup>th</sup> July 2026. We will endeavour to run these clubs weekly, but there may be occasions when school run clubs need to be cancelled to accommodate staff training; should this occur, we will inform you as soon as possible.

#### **Fine motor club: (Monday after school, 3.15pm-4.15pm) Years R - 6**

Each week your child will build hand strength and coordination through games, crafts, puzzles, playdough, construction, and creative challenges with Miss Kelly.

Maximum spaces – 15

#### **Homework club: (Tuesday after school, 3.15pm-4.15pm) Years R - 6**

This club will be run by Miss Smith. It will provide an opportunity for children to complete some of their class homework, including Mathswizz, TT Rockstars, reading and spellings in a supportive and encouraging environment. The club would be ideal for children who are unable to access the internet at home or find it difficult to focus. Whilst this club is a drop in club for children, we do ask that you let the office know prior to the club day, if you plan for your child to attend.

Maximum spaces – 16

#### **Gardening club: (Tuesday and Thursday lunch times, 12.30-1.00pm) Years 3 - 6**

We will be tending to the outside areas of our school. This will include weeding, pruning, planting, composting and considering ways to care for some of the wildlife that lives in the school grounds. This club will be a drop in club, where children can choose on the day if they wish to attend.

Maximum spaces – 12

#### **Keyboard club: (Thursday after school, 3.15pm-4.15pm) Years 2 - 4**
