Contribution to School

In line with the other schools in the Trust we have decided once again to ask for an annual contribution of £21.00 from each child this year to contribute to the cost of the visitors to our school. This will mean that parents are not inconvenienced by requests for small amounts of money during each term, but that we can continue to offer the broad and rich curriculum we are so proud of.

We envisage that contribution money will be spent on activities such as: History off the Page, specialist extra sports sessions, science workshops, singing sessions, GenR8 assemblies, Year 6 play leader training, reward days and many others. Offering the children experiences such as this is important not only for their educational development but also for their personal growth. We hope to prepare them to understand their places and roles in the wider world.

Without contributions from parents, we will be unable to provide some of these activities. These visitors and activities really help to enhance the curriculum and embed the children's learning. We prefer to have visitors to the school as they are a lot cheaper (no coach costs) and the children have a longer day for the chosen activity as there is no travel time.

I hope you will support the school with the contribution. All children enjoy the visits and we try to do at least one a term for each year group.

If you wish to pay in instalments, a payment of £7.00 per child, per term (payable in September, January & April) can also be made. Payment can be made via Arbor, please ensure that you add your Annual Contribution payment via the Trips section only.

Please note that the annual contribution does not cover the cost of trips out, i.e. day trips and residential trips. These will be charged separately.
