School clubs – Spring Term.

Our lunch time and after school clubs will commence the week beginning 12th January 2026. The clubs will run up to and including week commencing 16th March 2026. We will endeavour to run these clubs weekly, but there may be occasions when school run clubs need to be cancelled to accommodate staff training; should this occur, we will inform you as soon as possible. Please note in advance, that clubs will not run the week of 23rd February 2026, as this is our parent's consultation week.

Running club: (Monday after school, 3.15pm-4.15pm) Years 3 - 6

Miss Kelly will run this club for students to come and run together.

Maximum spaces – 15

Board game club: (Tuesday after school, 3.15pm-4.15pm) Years R - 6

Join Mrs Wiseman each week, where the children will play a variety of board games together.

Maximum spaces – 16

Gardening club: (Tuesday and Thursday lunch times, 12.30-1.00pm) Years 3 - 6

We will be tending to the outside areas of our school. This will include weeding, pruning, planting, composting and considering ways to care for some of the wildlife that lives in the school grounds. This club will be a drop in club, where children can choose on the day if they wish to attend.

Come and join Miss Smith's drawing club where you will explore creativity through guided drawing activities and plenty of opportunities for independent, free-choice artwork.
